In the *Ancient Greek* programme the language workshop includes practice in translation, getting to know the writers and the history and introduction to Modern Greek. In the *Languages United: Greek and Turkish Tandem* programme the language workshop is the Greek-Turkish Tandem.

**** Cultural and educational activities include presentations on history, the arts and society, Greek dance lesson, Greek cookery class, singing lesson, Greek film, cultural walks and visits.
